Incorporation of changes in the RMS Portal

At the outset, I would like to extend the heartfelt congratulations to your Department for receiving the State Level Civil Services Award for the development and state-wide implementation of the RMS portal. This recognition is a testament to the significant efforts of your Department.

I would like to draw your attention to letter No. 18015/05/2023-LRD dated 11-07-2024, received from the Department of Land Resources, Ministry of Rural Development, Government of India. The letter pertains to the provision of data related to Revenue Courts through an API for the national-level dashboard. As outlined in the attached letter (copy enclosed), this dashboard will display key performance indicators, and data related to Revenue Court cases forms a crucial part of these indicators. The API-related guidelines were also forwarded to your office by the said Department for necessary action.

The state has already implemented the Revenue Management System (RMS) across all Revenue Courts, and the management of Revenue cases is being carried out through the portal. However, the courts of the Settlement Tehsildar and Naib Tehsildar have not yet been on-boarded to the portal. To ensure the generation of accurate and comprehensive reports on Revenue cases, it is imperative that all Settlement Courts be integrated into the RMS portal.

In light of the above, you are kindly requested to implement the following provisions in the RMS portal:

1. Enable functionality at the Settlement Officer/Assistant Settlement Officer level for the creation of user accounts for Settlement Tehsildars/Naib Tehsildars in the RMS portal.
2. Assign distinct tags to all Settlement Courts, from the Settlement Officer to the Naib Tehsildar level, to ensure that reports for these courts are generated separately, without merging them with district-level court reports.
3. Facilitate the sharing of Revenue Court data from the RMS portal through an API with the Department of Land Resources.




4. Integration of Revenue Court cases with Land records, by consulting with NIC to get the data related to land (i.e. Ownership, Possession, Khata Numbers, Khatauni Numbers, Khasra Numbers/ Nakal Jamabandi and Nakal Musssvi) through API. The Remarks of the Revenue court cases should directly reflect in the remarks column of the Jamabandi.

Additionally, the "Modernization of the Revenue Court Management System" is identified as one of the key milestones in the Scheme for Special Capital Assistance to States - 2024. As part of this milestone, it is stated that the filing of Revenue Court cases should be made paperless. To achieve this, certain changes are required in the existing system. A detailed list of the necessary amendments is enclosed herewith.

You are kindly requested to oversee the incorporation of these changes into the RMS portal to enhance its utility for both citizens and departmental users.


