


Minutes of the Meeting held under the Chairmanship of Director (DT&G) on 09-12-2025 at 3:30 PM regarding implementation of HimAccess SSO and Aadhaar authentication of HimCare and SAHARA beneficiaries.

The following officers were present in the meeting

Gist of the meeting held and decisions taken during the meeting are as follows:


1. It was discussed that although the HimAccess Single Sign-On (SSO) has been integrated into the HPSBYS portal, enrolments/ renewal for HimCare and SAHARA schemes are still being carried out using ration card numbers without proper identity validation. It was suggested that HimAccess SSO must be made mandatory for all HIMCARE and SAHARA enrolment processes to ensure verified resident are enrolled to prevent enrolment of fraud/ghost beneficiaries.
2. It was further discussed that enrolment/renewal for HimCare card is done through the CSC centers. Additionally, Medical Superintendents (MS) have been provided the facility to enroll citizens for HIMCARE through their respective logins throughout the year. It was decided that Aadhaar-as-a-Service may be provided to HPSBYS to enable Aadhaar eKYC in the registration modules used by CSC operators and Medical Superintendents, so that eKYC of applicants can be conducted during the registration process to ensure accurate identity verification.
3. The Deputy Director (HPSBYS) highlighted the requirement for Aadhaar biometric authentication of beneficiaries in the Transaction Management System (TMS) during hospital treatment under HIMCARE. It was informed that DDT&G can develop and provide a dedicated mobile application to HPSBYS that enables hospital staff to initiate Aadhaar-based face authentication (or biometric authentication wherever feasible) of HimCare beneficiaries at the point of service delivery.
4. It was discussed that DDT&G has developed a survey mobile platform currently used by various departments, including ESOMA, for verification of social security pension beneficiaries. The same survey platform may be utilized by the HP Swasthya Bima



Yojna Society for the verification or obtaining digital life certificates of SAHARA beneficiaries.

It was further decided that HPSBYS shall provide a complete API of their existing system, as per requirements of technical team to enable DDTG to undertake the integration process as discussed at the earliest.

Meeting ended with vote of thanks to and from the chair.
