"NOTIFICATION"

In exercise of the powers conferred by proviso to Article 309 of the Constitution of India, the Governor, Himachal Pradesh, in consultation with the Himachal Pradesh Public Service Commission, is pleased to make the Recruitment and Promotion Rules, for the post of Investigator-Class-II, (Non Gazetted), in the Rural Development Department of Himachal Pradesh as per "Annexure-A" appended to this Notification, namely:-

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| 1. Short title and commencement | 1. (i) These Rules may be called the Himachal Pradesh Rural Development Department Investigator Class-II (Non - Gazetted) Recruitment and Promotion Rules, 2005.

(ii) These rules shall come into force from the date of Publication in the Rajpatra, Himachal Pradesh. |
| 2. Repeal and Savings Clause | 2. (i) The Himachal Pradesh Department of Rural Development, Class-III (Non-gazetted) (Technical) Service (Recruitment, Promotion and certain conditions of service) Rules, 1963 notified vide Notification No. d-6-45 (Estt.)/58- dated 10 th February, 1964 and as amended from time to time are hereby repealed, to the extent these pertain to the post of Investigator, Class-II (Non-Gazetted)

(ii) Notwithstanding such repeal, any appointment made, or anything done or any action taken under the rules, so repealed under rule 2(i) supra shall be deemed to have been validly made, done or taken under these Rules. |

**RECRUITMENT AND PROMOTION RULES FOR THE POST OF INVESTIGATOR
IN THE DEPARTMENT OF RURAL DEVELOPMENT H.P.**

By promotion from amongst Statistical Assistant/Senior Assistant(Progress) with 05 years' regular service or regular combined with continuous adhoc service rendered, if any, in the grade. Provided that for the purpose of promotion a combined seniority list of eligible officials based on the length of service in their respective cadres without disturbing their cadre-wise inter-seniority shall be prepared.

(1) In all cases of promotion, the continuous adhoc service rendered in the feeder post, if any, prior to regular appointment to the post shall be taken into account towards the length of service as prescribed in these Rules for promotion subject to the condition that the adhoc appointment / promotion in the feeder category had been made after following proper acceptable process of selection in accordance with the provisions of R & P Rules, provided that:-

(i) in all cases where a Junior person becomes eligible for consideration by virtue of his/her total length of service (including the service rendered on adhoc basis, followed by regular service/ appointment) in the feeder post in view of the provision referred to above, all persons senior to him/her in the respective category / post / cadre shall be deemed to be eligible for consideration and placed above the junior person in the field of consideration;

Provide that all incumbents to be considered for promotion shall possess the minimum qualifying service of at least three years' or that prescribed in the R & P Rules for the post, whichever is less;

Provided further that where a person becomes ineligible to be considered for promotion on account of the requirements of the preceding proviso, the person(s) junior to him / her shall also be deemed to be ineligible for consideration for such promotion.

EXPLANATIONS:- The last proviso shall not render the junior incumbent(s) indigible for consideration for promotion if the senior ineligible person(s) happened to be Ex-Servicemen recruited under the provisions of Rule-3 of Demobilised Armed Forces Personnel (Reservation of Vacancies in Himachal State Non-Technical Service) Rules, 1972 and having been given the benefit of seniority there-under or recruited under the provisions of Rule-3 of Ex-Servicemen(Reservation of Vacancies in the Himachal Pradesh Technical Services) Rules, 1985 and having been given the benefit of seniority there-under.

(2) Similarly, in all cases of confirmation, adhoc service rendered on the feeder post, if any, prior to the regular appointment / promotion against such post shall be taken into account towards the length of service, if the adhoc appointment / promotion had been made after proper selection and in accordance with the provisions of the R & P rules.

Provided that inter-se-seniority as a result of confirmation after taking into account, adhoc service rendered as referred to above shall remain un-changed.
