Proceedings of the meeting held on 20-12-2025 at 12:30 PM under the Chairmanship of the Director (IT) at DDT&G, IT Bhawan, Mehli-13, of State level Committee regarding issuance of CSC IDs to PACS group.

At the outset, the chairman welcomed all the members. The State Head, CSC SPV, apprised the Committee that requests have been received for creation of 195 CSC IDs for Primary Agricultural Credit Societies (PACS). Further, there is no specific mention regarding groups such as SHG, PACS, or FPS in LMK policy. The competent authority had approved that a State level committee be constituted for taking a decision on such requests for creation of CSC IDs in respect of groups like SHG, Post offices, PACS etc. This is first meeting of the committee. After detailed deliberation, the following decisions were taken:

1. It was discussed and decided that, in the first phase, CSC IDs shall be issued to PACS located in Panchayats where no LMK/CSC is currently established.
2. CSC SPV shall provide the list of such Panchayats and create CSC IDs accordingly.
3. In the second phase, in Panchayats where LMKs are already operational, CSC IDs shall be issued only to those PACS where no other LMK/CSC centre exists within a minimum distance of 1 km, either by road or footpath. This condition has been prescribed to avoid conflicts between VLEs, ensure optimal utilisation of existing LMKs/CSCs, maintain financial viability of centres, and promote equitable distribution of service delivery points across the Panchayats/locations.
4. CSC SPV shall physically verify each PACS centre, and CSC IDs shall be issued only after confirming that the above distance criteria is fulfilled.

5. Permission to open an LMK/CSC centre shall be granted only at the registered address of the PACS, and only to those PACS that fulfil the above criteria.
6. CSC SPV shall submit a detailed report to this Department indicating the number of CSC IDs created out of the 195 requests received, along with the physical verification reports from the field.

The meeting ended with a vote of thanks to and from the chair.




